Certificate Course in Infertility Counseling (Spring, 2018)

Health care professionals are playing an increasingly important role in reproductive medicine due to technological advances and recognition of the complex psychosocial issues faced by infertility patients. As a result, there is a growing need across different countries for the skills and services of trained infertility counselors to assist patients and staff. Infertility counseling includes psychological assessment, psychotherapeutic intervention, and psycho-educational support of individuals and couples who are experiencing fertility problems.

The prospective course will be co-organized by the Department of Social Work and Social Administration, HKU and the Hong Kong Society for Reproductive Medicine. In 2010, we have started the first certificate course as a pilot scheme. This is the **fifth Certificate Course on Infertility Counseling for local healthcare professionals** working on assisted reproduction technologies.

After completing the course, each participant will be presented a certificate of attendance issued by the Department of Social Work and Social Administration, HKU and the Hong Kong Society for Reproductive Medicine. The course structure is developed from the guidelines offered by the Mental Health Professional Group of the American Society for Reproductive Medicine. This is to help determine the qualifications and training for mental health professionals working in reproductive medicine.

Objectives

- ❖ To equip healthcare professionals with the medical, psychosocial, legal and ethical perspectives as well as their implications towards infertility and assisted reproduction technologies
- To introduce different approaches intervening with clients undergoing various types of assisted reproduction technologies
- To enrich professional and personal competence in working as helping professionals

The course will be comprised of twelve 2.5-hour lectures with one half-day workshop.
